



- 1. In reference to DM-CT-2024-387 titled Workshop on the Development of Contextualized Learning Delivery Guides for Learners with disabilities (LWDs) (K, Grades 1, 4, and 7) dated September 25, 2024, this Office issues the list of identified participants for the aforementioned activity at Great Eastern Hotel, Quezon City on October 15-18, 2024.
- 2. The workshop aims to:
 - a. collaboratively refine and finalize the prototype contextualized learning delivery guides, ensuring they effectively incorporate Universal Design for Learning (UDL) principles and address the needs of learners with disabilities, across all learning areas. As outlined in RA 11650 known as "Instituting a Policy of Inclusion and Services for Learners with Disabilities in Support of Inclusive Education Act", Universal Design for Learning (UDL) refers to a flexibility in presenting information, diverse responses and demonstration of knowledge, and reduces barriers in instruction. Through the application of UDL principles, the participants will finalize proposed accommodations and modifications, creating contextualized learning delivery guides that foster inclusive and engaging learning experiences for all students.
 - ensure the finalized learning guides are highly accessible and inclusive, with appropriate accommodations and modifications as part of the teaching and learning procedure, meeting the diverse needs of all learners, including those with disabilities; and
 - c. solidify a school-wide commitment to inclusive practices and foster a culture of support for learners with disabilities through the use of the finalized contextualized learning delivery guides.
- 3. Participants in this activity are select school heads and supervisors with a strong background in teaching learners with disabilities to serve as contributors to the said workshop.
