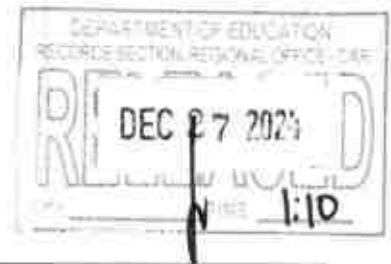

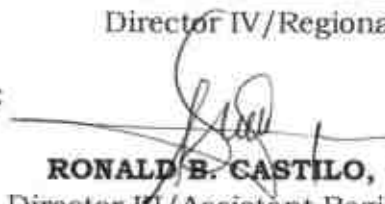

We are getting close to being able to draw the PISA students from the sampled school(s) in your Divisions for the PISA 2025 Main Survey (MS). As part of the sampling process, we have pre-identified all PISA-eligible students (*Attachment 2*) from which the PISA students shall be drawn. The prepared lists must first be confirmed by the School Heads (SHs) and Division Testing Coordinators (DTCs) before we can draw the students who will sit in the test. *Attachment 1* contains the detailed instructions for this task.

In addition, because PISA 2025 MS will be administered as a computer-based assessment (CBA), it is crucial that the computers of the sampled school shall pass the minimum computer requirements for PISA. As such, the Information Technology Officer (ITO) of your Division, together with the DTC, is requested to accomplish the *PISA 2025 SRT Results Form (Attachment 3)* with the School Readiness Tool User Guide as the reference.

After accomplishing these tasks, the DTC shall submit the completed forms to the PISA National Center on or before **3 January 2025** through email at **pisa.phl@deped.gov.ph**.

Instructions for Student List Verification Form Completion

The Student List contains information of PISA-eligible students in your school. PISA-eligible students are those:

1. currently enrolled in Grade 7 or higher; AND
2. born between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2009.

To the School Head (SH)

1. Check if the names on the Student List are your students.
2. Check if the pre-filled information for each student in the list are true and correct.
3. Provide the correct information in the "Corr" sheet if incorrect information about the student is supplied. Then, add the nature of the correction in the Comment column.
4. Verify the list of students with special education needs under the SEN column and submit the verification documents (e.g. PWD ID, Medical Certificate, Diagnostic Report) of these students for confirmation. If there are students who are not tagged as LSEN, kindly note this in the "Corr" sheet.
5. **Do NOT remove any students or make any corrections in the PISA student list.** If a student is no longer in school or is **INELIGIBLE** based on the two criteria listed above, kindly note this in the "Corr" sheet.
6. Once done, save the file **WITHOUT CHANGING THE FILENAME**. Do not make any structural changes in the worksheet (removing/adding any columns and rows or changing fonts, rows and columns sizes).
7. Submit the file to the Division Testing Coordinator (DTC) for verification.

To the DTC

1. Verify if the proposed corrections by the School Head (SH) are true and correct. If so, put OK in the "Verification" column of the "Corr" sheet. Otherwise, indicate your comment and return the file to the SH for correction.
2. Once all entries are verified, submit this form together with the School Readiness Tool (SRT) Results for each sampled school to pisa.ph@deped.gov.ph or before **3 January 2025**. Use the subject line: [SCHOOL NAME] PISA 2025 MS_LST_SRT (e.g. [MANILA HIGH SCHOOL] PISA 2025 MS_LST_SRT)

1 Introduction

PISA 2025 will be delivered as an online assessment via a browser-based application.

It is important to establish whether the computers and laptops that students will use to administer PISA can successfully run the assessment.

The School Readiness Tool (SRT) assesses the compatibility of the schools' IT resources with the assessment platform and identifies if they perform at the appropriate level.

This user guide provides details about the technical requirements and the instructions for running the SRT.

2 Purpose of the SRT

The School Readiness Tool is intended for schools to assess their schools' IT capacity to deliver PISA online.

3 Device requirements

The device requirements for the assessment platform are:

5 Internet requirements

The below graph provides a guidance if you plan to test a different number of concurrent test takers.

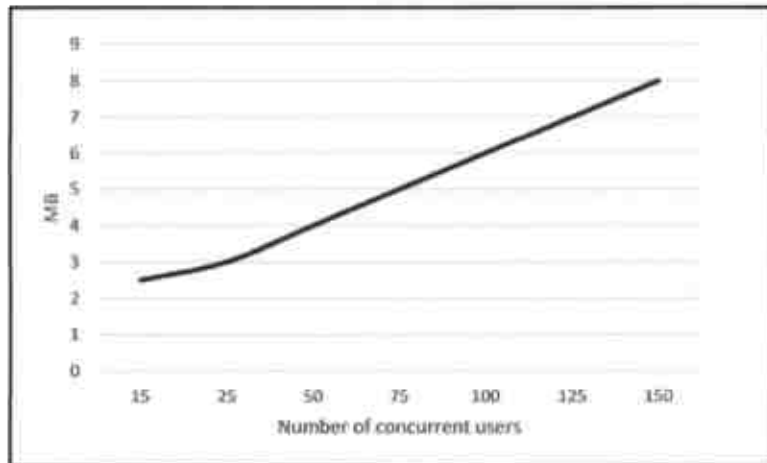


Figure 1 Recommended download speed

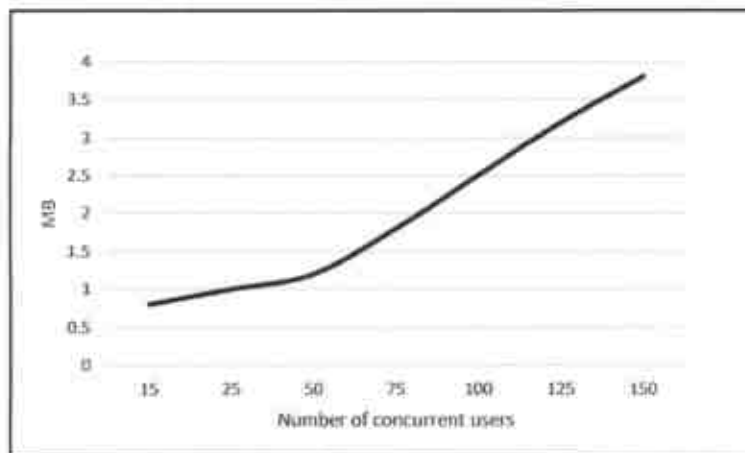


Figure 2 Recommended upload speed

Figures 1 and 2 show the estimated bandwidth needed for uploading and downloading by the number of concurrent users. The lines are not “go/no go” criteria, they are estimates and approximate.

The National Centre will need to review schools near the line and decide if there is enough evidence to support that these schools can administer PISA online or not; for example, if they have conducted online assessments before or if they use computers/laptops and the internet often.

Connectivity

Whitelisting a domain is a security measure where specific web addresses (domains) are explicitly allowed to communicate with a network or application. Whitelisting ensures that traffic to and from specific web addresses is permitted within the network's security settings, allowing users to access essential resources without being blocked by firewalls or content filters.

In the SRT test, we are checking the connection to all domains needed:

- TestRunner
- Google CDN

Web socket Compatibility

WebSockets reduce latency and improve data exchange efficiency by maintaining an open connection, allowing both parties to send and receive data immediately as needed.

By thoroughly verifying both WebSocket compatibility and domain whitelisting, schools can ensure that their network infrastructure supports real-time to allow seamless user experience.

The SRT is the tool schools will use to undertake the technical preparation activities to determine the most effective way to deliver PISA. For these reasons, it is important to run the SRT several times. Considering the computers/laptops students will use to participate in PISA, the SRT should be run:

- on all computers/laptops with different configurations
- using different browsers
- at different times of the school day and the school week.

7 Results

After running the SRT several times, you will need to review the results from running the SRT and provide your results to the Bureau of Education Assessment using the *SRT Results Form* (see Attachment 2).

If a device has met all the system specifications, then the PISA assessment can be delivered online.

If a device does not meet all the system specifications, then this requires further investigation (see Section 8 Troubleshooting).

8 Troubleshooting

As a starting point, check the usage of the platform to determine usage levels, check the equipment, reset the network and run the SRT again.

Issue	Action
Internet connectivity is poor OR latency has failed	Please ensure you are running the SRT in a timeframe that will be comparable to the period when students will be completing the PISA assessment. If the problem persists, please contact your internet provider.
Browser has failed	Please update your browser or install a supported browser from the list provided under Section 4. System Requirements
Internet network conflict (such as having wifi enabled, when the student computers/laptops are physically connected to the school network)	Please ensure you are using the correct network when running the SRT.
WebSocket compatibility fails	There are instances where WebSocket connections fail to establish successfully, leading to WebSocket errors like interrupted data transmission and compromised functionality. Here are some common reasons for WebSocket connection failures and their corresponding solutions: Network Issues: Unstable or unreliable network connections can lead to WebSocket connection failures.
